The V series features reinforced rip-stop polyethylene tarps that are water and wind proof. The LX series tarps are made of 420-denier nylon. They are very leak resistant, windproof, hold heat well and breathe to prevent condensation. With proper care your shelter should last for many years to come. ### **SETTING UP YOUR ICE SHELTER**



1. Open shelter on a flat surface taking care not to pinch the fabric between the plastic bases.
2. Unfold tarp. Align bottom of tarp to perimeter of plastic base. Connect the snap hooks on the tarp to eyelets on the plastic base. This is only necessary on the initial set up.
3. Unzip a door and step inside the shelter.
4. Unfold end “U” shaped frame. Assemble poles to “U” shaped top frame. Swing frame up so it fits tightly in top corners. Repeat procedure for the other frame end.
5. Connect center support bar(s) together and snap one end near lanyard on the frame assembly. Snap the other end of the center support to the other end of the frame about one foot away from center point and slide in towards the center of the frame. Center the center support between the end frames.
6. From outside the shelter lift the snow dam skirt around the bottom perimeter of the base and tighten each strap so the tarp fits snugly around frame and base. Lay out snow dam skirt.

### **ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR V300 AND LX 300**

To protect your favorite fishing rods, the doors can be secured in the open position by snapping the strap attached to the door to the corner pole.

### **HELPFUL SUGGESTIONS**

- Shelter should only be pulled by hand. Pulling the unit behind a snowmobile, ATV or any other motorized vehicle will result in the unit slamming into the back of the tow vehicle when the vehicle stops.
- It is a good idea to position your shelter lengthwise (door side) into the wind for least resistance and added ventilation.
- Use the recessed area on base for positioning a five-gallon bucket for seating.
- Additional gear may be loaded on top of base and secured in place with a bungee cord.

### **CARE, MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE**

- When closing shelter make sure the collapsed poles do not lie directly on hinge joint. Interference may cause damage to hinge.
- Refrain from creasing window(s). Lay window(s) as flat as possible prior to closing to reduce creases.
- Care must be taken when handling the tarp. Although it is an industrial weight fabric, it is still subject to damage from sharp objects like auger blades or abuse.
- Avoid placing heaters or lanterns too close to the fabric. Leave doors open slightly at the top corners for ventilation.
- Ensure the tarp is clean and dry before it is stored at the end of the season to avoid odor, mold and mildew.

#### **WARNING**

This shelter is made of flame resistant fabric. It is not fireproof. It will burn if left in contact with a flame source. Never use an open flame of any kind inside or near the shelter. If using heaters or lanterns, ventilate using bi-directional zippers on the doors. The fabric meets CPAI-84 fire retardant specifications.
